Your SpyX Micro Periscope lets you see over fences or around corners. You can see without being seen!

The Parts of the Micro Periscope (Fig. 1 & 2)

Periscope Tube- (it extends and collapses as needed)

Lens Swivels - (rotate 60, 90, or 180 degrees).

Mirrors - There is one mirror under each lens.

Mirror Adjustment Knob- Twist to move the mirrors into Telescope or Periscope mode.

Eye Piece lens- You look through this lens.

Objective lens- You point this lens at what you want to see.

Telescope Eye Piece lens- Look through this lens to see straight ahead.

Belt clip- Look through this lens to see straight ahead.

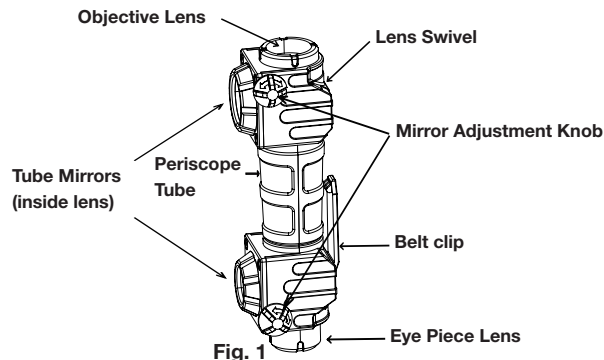

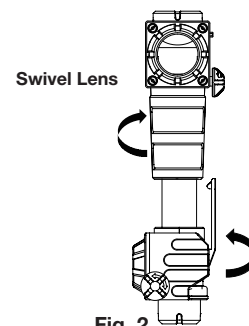

The Micro Periscope has 2 modes.

The Periscope Mode: (Fig. 3) twist the mirror adjustment knob as indicated. (when you look at each lens the mirrors should not be reflecting back at you)

- Extend the tube
- Look through the Eye Piece lens and swivel the Objective lens to point in the direction of what you want to see. You can look ahead, or to either side **or even behind you!**

The Telescope Mode: (Fig. 3) twist the mirror adjustment knob as indicated so that both mirrors are angled up. (when you look at each lens the mirrors should be flat and reflecting back at you)

- Look through the Telescope lens eye piece.
- Extend or collapse the Tube length to adjust the focus.

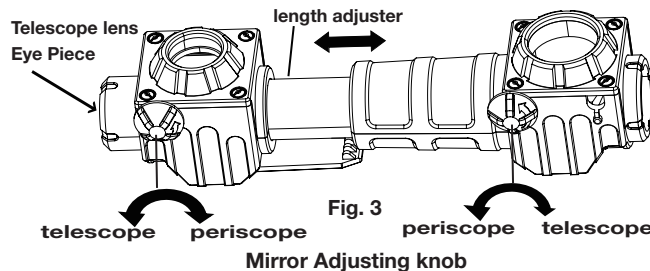
